

Welcome to the life and ministry of Calvary Temple Church.

2019 has been a year filled with many opportunities and challenges. You will note that again our Annual General Meeting is happening one hour earlier, including childcare, and hopefully encouraging young families to include themselves in this way in the life of our church family.

The WHY Book delivery happened in September of 2019. I was so encouraged by the prayer emphasis that happened all year long, culminating in the delivery of over 45,000 WHY books in our city. We continue to pray that these books will be like beacons of hope in thousands of homes across our city. We continue to pray on Saturday mornings, also this year we've added Prayer and Fasting on the third Thursday of every month.

As you peruse the pages of this year's financial and ministry reports, we are so thankful for God's provision in people and finances. Overall, a very encouraging year. The missions money you gave to our Shared Funding Partners increased this past year. We continue setting faith-filled goals for missions in 2020.

Our Pastoral Team continues to give good equipping leadership in all areas of ministry. The ministry reports are worth a read.

What an exciting year of ministry! 2019 was a wonderful year in our lives and in our ministry at Calvary Temple. Becky and I feel so blessed to be a part of the Calvary Temple family. This year we celebrated our 11th summer of ministry and we are so thankful for the wonderful privilege we have to serve alongside so many wonderful staff and volunteers.

January gave Becky and I the opportunity to visit and minister alongside some of our missionary partners in Mozambique and Russia. In Mozambique we had the opportunity to share our hearts on the importance of ministering to children and youth. In Russia, at a secular camp conference, we had a unique opportunity to share about the power of Christian camping to transform lives. We then spent time training a group of committed volunteers at the church in Tambov to run summer camps. It was thrilling to see their video at the end of the summer highlighting their camping ministry.

Here at home, the H.H. Barber Retreat Centre continues to be used by many different groups from within the church and the Christian community. Our winter camps are quickly becoming a favorite of our 8-12-year-old campers. In June we hosted our church family open house at our camp. We had more than 300 people come together to enjoy all that our camp has to offer. We were blessed to have Jim and Joanne Poirier minister to the families at our family camp on the September long weekend.

We were so pleased to serve 453 campers throughout the summer with 117 children making first time commitments to Christ! We also had over 250 children indicate that they had grown in their faith during their week of camp. Once again we ran a full spring break day camp program. We were excited to have 62 children participate in the program. Highlights of the week include the many crafts and games and being able to use the gym for many activities as well as the carnival bouncers and games. It was a fantastic week and we look forward to having March Break camp again this coming year. A special thanks to the students and volunteers who gave of their time to help make this program a success.

We are excited about 2020 and believing in God for great things. We are excited about continuing our partnership with Union Gospel Mission, which sees funding provided for over 140 children to attend camp this summer! In addition to this funding we were also very fortunate to receive funding from The Winnipeg Foundation. This allowed us to sponsor over 200 children and youth this past summer. We hope to be able to continue doing this in the future. God has truly blessed this camp ministry and we give all the honour and glory to Him for all of the great things that He has done.















As my role at the church has continued to evolve I am very grateful to serve alongside many talented and faithful volunteers in various departments. I am privileged to work alongside the Board. I am truly thankful for the Godly wisdom they provide. I also appreciate the unseen efforts of our accountant Rob Franks who works diligently to keep our financial house in order.

This past year has seen us take on the challenge of addressing some significant capital needs around the church and at camp. Most notably, a major bathroom renovation completed on the main floor of the sanctuary building. Glen Hiebert, alongside volunteer Ken Hiebert, carried a significant role in seeing this long-anticipated project through to completion. A big thanks to them and the team for a job well done. We also moved towards greater accessibility as electric door openers were added to both the front and back doors of the Argue Building and the Sanctuary Building. As a church we also paid off a significant portion of the mortgage and purchased a new boat for the camp. As we enter into 2020 we look foward to the restoration of the tower, renovation of the youth lounge and updating the flooring in both buildings, as our focus for the second half of the capital campaign.

In other areas, I want to show my appreciation to Evelyn Yeung who gives leadership to our library. The ministry has expanded over the last few years and is now being used regularly by the students of St. Aidan's Christian School.

Merrilyn Hall continues to do an amazing job giving leadership to our Wee College ministry. Currently our fourth child is in the program. This has kept our house filled with all the songs and memory verses that teach the fundamentals of the faith.

CSB and Guardians continue to receive excellent leadership under the care of Gord Banman and Darlene Klassen. Along with their teams, they continue to train up our young people in their Bible knowledge, allowing them to become people of strong Christian character.

Lastly, I would like to acknowledge the many programs that are led by lay leaders and are a vital part of the community of Calvary Temple. These ministries include the men and women's ministries, Connections, Ladies Bible Study, Play Groups, and many other special events that happen throughout the year. I would urge all who call Calvary Temple home to get involved in one of these amazing ministries and be a contributing part in this amazing community of believers, known as Calvary Temple Church.

Big City Avenue is our K to Grade 5 ministry. This high energy kids worship service includes small group times where kids can get to know one another and personally apply the Bible lessons shared in the large

group setting. Special features and guests, such as Professor Whatchamacallit and The Secret Agent, capture the kids attention. The BCA Store continues to be popular as an incentive and reward centre for kids. Toby & Gracie, our mascots, were introduced in July and are a big hit with the kids. We are delighted to see kids growing in grace and in their relationship with Jesus week by week.

During the summer months of July and August, we hosted a weekday afternoon drop-in program from Monday to Thursday each week. Activities took place in the youth lounge and in the gym as well as organized outings such as the Central Park Splash Pad. Recreation and relationship bonds go hand-in-hand and kids were able to connect with each other and with the leaders. These relationships are crucial to the growth of faith of the young people. With the assistance of Manitoba Green Team and Canada Summer Jobs funding we were able to utilize the services of two interns to help to make this outreach a reality.

Two Family Fun Nights were hosted this summer, one at Assiniboine Park and a second at Kildonan Park. These events were both highly successful in terms of strengthening relationships among kids and their families as well as integrating new families into the life and ministry of CT. Thank you to everyone who lent a hand or who came out to participate.

We were thrilled with the response to our inaugural P-A-K (Parents And Kids) Night at Big City Avenue in October. A real sense of God's presence was felt by all who attended. What could be better than families worshiping together and receiving God's Word together on a Saturday evening? Not much!!

We are so very thankful to the dynamic leaders who serve with us. Most serve every week in both a.m. services!! What an incredible commitment!! Others come bi-weekly and some monthly. All in all, we are amazed at the awesome gifts and talents that God has drawn together to serve the precious kids who come each and every week. ### **Sunday Afternoon Kids**

In the winter and the fall of 2019 kids from the inner city and north end neighbourhoods were bussed to the church for the afternoon program that includes a focus on Bible lessons and also includes a hot meal. Three programs based on ages are offered, these are Lil'K for the youngest, Kid Zone for Grade School ages and Youth Zone for teens. For twenty weeks each year, volunteers gather under the leadership of Mathew Dueck, Sharilyn Daher, Anna Morgante and Pastor Phil, assisted administratively by Zonia Roca, to minister the love and grace of God to these precious kids and teens. None of this could happen without the dedicated men and women of the transportation ministry who ensure that buses run, and are fueled and ready to go each week. Betty Campbell and the hospitality team provide excellent meals for the kids and workers who share in relationship around the tables. Faith is growing in young hearts and lives through this excellent outreach.



#### Counselling

**French Fellowship**- We partly adopted the early church model of ministry focusing on gathering together for Sunday services, visitation of homes twice a month, and outreach particularly to those who are unchurched. In those visitations we study and share the Word of God, pray for one another and share food. The results have been tremendous. Seekers have found Jesus as their Saviour, believers have strengthened their faith, and family relationships have been restored. Those who were sick have been healed and the demon possessed have been set free by the grace of God and have accepted Jesus as their personal Saviour.

#### Filipino Fellowship

- Greg Hermosura and the team are doing an excellent job. Their fellowship growing, both spiritually and numerically. Their support of new immigrants is amazing. Their Christmas outreach last year was the biggest one. Praise be to God.

This fellowship continues to care about missions and helping new immigrants.

**Portuguese Fellowship** - Virginia Ribeiro and her team hold a weekly worship service on Saturday mornings in the Deaf Chapel. They enjoy praising God and hearing the Word of God in their mother tongue. This fellowship enjoys getting together with each other, they also sense that they belong to the larger family of CT.

**African Fellowship** - We would like to thank the following individuals; Patrick & Marcella, Obbi & Rose, Emmanuel & Jesca, and Grace Okot for opening their homes for fellowship and Bible study. This has been a blessing to many. I had the opportunity to share the Word of God at the Sudanese Centre once a month. Many of them are not at a point of being willing to go to a church yet, so it's a blessing that they get to hear the Word of God in their setting.

Mission to Uganda and Democratic Republic of Congo (RDC) - This has been the most thrilling mission we worked on in 2019. Pastor H.H. Barber donated 200 books for us to give and we printed 2000 copies each of "Freedom Through Forgiveness" and "Healing Relationships" in both English and Swahili. Also, 1000 copies were translated into French and 2500 copies in Arabic were printed in Juba. In Congo, we had conferences in two different cities, Goma and Bukavu.
